### Cl. 044 YNYSYMAENGWYN TRUST UPDATE

A meeting was held with an officer from Snowdonia National Park regarding access to the Afon Dysynni; he is also to meet other landowners in the area and seek agreement from all parties.

The AA (Hotel and Hospitality Service) conducted and inspection of the site and its facilities on Wed. 19 May and awarded the site with a 4-pendant rating with a score of 85%.

Three raised beds have been created in the walled garden with nearly 150 plants and flowering shrubs planted or in the process of being planted.
